## Objectives

1. To study the background, message, and theology of the Book of Hebrews.
2. To develop an understanding and response to critical theological passages.
3. To apply the message of the book to our lives and ministries.

## Procedures

1. Class times will involve lecture and discussion of Hebrews and discussion of textual issues from the Epistle and our textbook: *Be Confident* by Warren Werisbe.
2. There will be a weekly 1 page Response Paper from a key question in the Book of Hebrews.
3. There will be no exams but a 5-6 page Theme Paper on a major topic will be due at the end of the course.
